Jujitsu developments Banzai international n° 1 1986

"In the past we have made quite a few mistakes," Robert Clark, the national coach of the British Jujitsu Association told me. We sat in his office at the Barlow's Lane Hombu, Liverpool, and in the background I could hear the sound of racing motor cycles tearing around the nearby Aintree race track.

Mr Robert Clark and I had been discussing the rapid expansion that has taken place within the BJJ this last couple of years. The expansion has been so pronounced that it has been necessary to enlarge and revamp the Liverpool club and to open an extended London dojo.

"We took people into membership to give them the possibility of Martial Arts Commission recognition. We hoped that, by training with us, they would improve their own standards. This has proven not to be in a few cases and, in future, we will

rely only upon our own trained instructors," he continued. At the outset, there were many different schools of jujitsu in Britain and the first attempts to form a board brought many of them in. Others joined later. Liverpool was the nucleus of the most developed groups and it contained the only people who were actually prepared to work administratively, coordinating development, etc. In jujitsu, as in all the Martial Arts, there are many people whose idea of work is to tell other people what to do; but there are precious few who will actually go out and do it.

Clark acknowledges the existence of styles of jujitsu but is not prepared to fall into karate's trap by allowing them to become equal to the whole.

Mr Clark feels that a style is a commitment to selected principals, to the detriment of others. He prefers to teach his students all aspect of jujitsu. If it takes a long time to do that, then so be it. Jujitsu can't be learned during an afternoon!

In case you might think that the BJJ has no tradition, or pedigree, speak to Grand Master Tsuyoshi Inoue who just happens to be the 18th master of Hontai Yoshin Ryu. There is precious little jujitsu left in Japan now and Inouye represents one of the oldest schools still extant.

Inouye is so impressed with the BJJ and National Coach Clark's teachings that he has called for a mutual recognition and cooperation! As of now, all BJJ grades are recognized in Japan - by the traditionalists themselves!

Clark's training methods are based upon a lifetime of serious study. He has stepped outside the boundaries of jujitsu in order to recognize its limitations. I looked thorough some of the photograph albums at the Honbu. These bear silent testimony to the man's research. I saw him sparring with Benny The Jet' Urquidez, practicing Escrima with Danny Inosanto, putting a wick-end lock on Malaysian Kung fu master, discussing technique with Hee il Cho and the origin of Hapkido with Bow San Han. If Bruce Lee was alive, no doubt I would have seen a photograph of him there too!

I am totally underwhelmed by certificates from The Intergalactic Union odd Old Sokes & 10th Dan certificates from the Aikwik-



warang jujitsu Union of Titicaca, but Clark's approach do so from a position of inferiority No challenger could have the same pedigree, recognition or ability.

Those students he has taught have proven to be the best and he singled out John Steadman and Alan Campbell for special praise. These two gents are respectively 5th Dan and 3rd Dan, gained after more than 15 years of hard practice.

He regards people of their caliber as being the vanguards for future world jujitsu development.

Stedman is his personal student, having come to jujitsu from karate 15 years ago. Whilst not knocking karate in any way, he found the tramlines square-bashing satisfied him less than the practical flow of jujitsu. An ex keen amateur boxer. Steadman has always sought to test the viability of his Art within the Dojo. He reported favorably on the value of coaching as a way of

learning a technique anew, through someone else's practice. Explaining the way to perform a technique has given him new insights and a better personal interpretation within the established framework.

Alan Campbell has trained for 14 years and is a full time teacher, operating five Dojos for the Association. When I visited the Honbu, he was running a class of eighty children, watched by their parents from the coffee lounge. I asked him if he was worried about teaching Martial Arts techniques to children as young as seven.

His response was that young children are taken in and trained in a special way, so that dangerous techniques are eliminated and what emerges is almost a form of skilled amateur wrestling. After six months or so, Alan has come to know the child and his parents and can judge for himself whether it is safe to continue training him. This careful screening has resulted in absolutely no reports of jujitsu techniques being used in playgrounds or parks.

Both Campbell and Steadman display the Sempai/Kohai relationship, which is the backbone of the new BJJ. They have been personally trained and their loyalty to jujitsu is unreserved. Not for them the ridiculous high grades of others. What price, for instance, a 6th Dan if a "mere" Sandan from Honbu can turn you over? Clark's youngest students echo this loyalty. I spoke to Lisa O'Shea, a Blue Belt ten-year-old in Alan Campbell's class. She was modest and quietly spoken, professing a great interest in the jujitsu games which follow the formal class. Earlier that afternoon, I had seen her wrestling her training partner down to the mat and holding her there to win the spirited bout. She is determined to get, a Black Belt. Stephen Cowsey is a seven-year-old who has trained at the Honbu now for two years. Like Lisa, he comes twice a week and is a Blue Belt. He is deeply into Randori and I saw him using some quite efficient hold downs during practice.

spect. To see the rooms of the old cinema skilfully built as a gym; to hear the wood board cracking as we walked; the smell of the

wax, with a hint of incense, made the moment mystic. The sensation of living a dream was overwhelming, a story of heroes and warriors, of dynasties of samurai becoming reality, a reality that we were a part of. We wished we could stay in that moment forever. The hours of training flew by and the sessions with the UK instructors were like so many we had experienced in our own Dojo. The training sessions led by Shihan Brian Truby helped us to feel and experience the living Syllabus of the Dojo of Soke Robert Clark. We were woken up from a wonderful dream when the sessions ended. Many photos were taken with new friends, rendered eternal the moments and testify to our great experience in the Dojo of Soke Robert Clark.

After the lessons of jujitsu, thanks to Shihan Hart and his wife Carol we discovered Liverpool, the people, the shops and the great port.

The return trip was a mixture of memories, anecdotes and proposals for the future. Thanks to the teacher, Maestro Colombini who allowed us to have this experience, we understand the real teaching of the Dai Soke.

The WJJF is not in the nice speeches, is not in the belts or in the passage of Dan. The WJJF is not to demonstrate to know more, to be more prepared or sharper than others. The WJJF is a great Dojo, with inside a heart, the heart of Dai Soke, that is beating again strongly, united by people whose generosity, tenacity and passion, have the will to stay together to enjoy and develop beyond the technique.

The Dojo in Fazakerley as Shihan Bob Hart rightly says is the only real Dojo of the Dai Soke. It is the Dojo in which all who enter to practice jujitsu live in harmony with one another, and goes out taking a part of the tatami, leaving a part of himself.

What we understood, what our teacher Colombini always taught us, and that we are teaching in our dojo, is a true sense of the sweet art, one that permeates each aspect of our lives, and the lives of our students.

We will always remember with gratitude and friendship Shihan Robert Hart and his wife Carol for their great hospitality, which allowed us to feel as at home, and all the WJJF UK for helping us to understand that we are one great and united family.

"Uniform Requirements" for the NORTH AMERICAN OPENTRADITIONAL KODOKAN JUDO CHAMPIONSHIPS

Section 1 - At USA-TKJ sanctioned events, All Competitors must wear an All-White Judo Gi for competition. The uniform cannot be so tight or so loose as to give an "unfair advantage" to the wearer of the gi. The sleeves of the competitor's uniform must extend past the elbow to approximately center between the elbow and the wrist, but shall not cover the wrist. The pants of the competitor's uniform must extend below the knee covering most of the shin, but must be at least one inch above the mat. Sleeves or pants shall not be rolled-up or cuffed-up on the competitor's uniform during a match. Competitors should bring at least two uniforms to all USA-TKJ Competitive Events (for safety - in case any bleeding on the gi occurs). If bleeding does occur, the match will be stopped and gi(s) with blood will be exchanged with the competitor's extra (clean) gi. Competitors are required to provide their "own" red and blue belts to all USA-TKJ competitions. The competitor will be instructed as to which color belt to wear prior to each match by the referee.

Section 2 - At the North American Open Judo Championships, there can be no more than two (2) patches, logos, or adornments of any type (except for brand insignia & shoulder stripes on the jacket) on the Gi that a competitor wears in the NORTH AMERICAN OPENTKJ CHAMPIONSHIPS.




